- 2 The ingress corner cleanup area looks good. Starting to get some ground palm growth as expected. We will continue to monitor for Vine growth.
- 3 The thinning of the ground palms along the medians will continue progress so far looks great
- 4 There's an area in the median right before you get to Caribbean that has some encroaching grass and weed growth. Please spray out this area.

- 5 There is a small dead pine tree in the median between Caribbean and Antigua Way, I will submit the info to Laura and the town to have it removed
- 6 Several of the pines in the median are in poor shape and appear to have pine beetles, the bark is falling off significantly. There is nothing you can do for them. We'll just have to monitor and have the town remove any dead pines we find
- 7 There is a large dead pine just south of the Caribbean and Bluewater Boulevard intersection. I will submit the location to Laura for the town to remove
- 8 There are two more dead pines at the median just north of the circle where the oaks and Pines stop in the crêpe myrtles begin. This will be reported for removal.


